- Apartments:** 184 fully appointed apartments for up to 6 guests with maritime-themed interior designs in 6 categories, ranging from 52 m<sup>2</sup> to 161 m<sup>2</sup>. All have a separate bedroom, living and dining area, 32 to 55-inch flat-screen TV, free Wi-Fi, safe, hair dryer, modern kitchen with fridge-freezer, dishwasher, oven, coffee maker, kettle and toaster as well as vacuum cleaner, iron, ironing board, balcony with seating. Almost all of the apartments offer lake views.
- Restaurant & bar:** **Bella Riva:** Comprehensive breakfast buffet, Mediterranean delicacies at lunch and dinner time, pizza, pasta and burgers as well as refreshing aperitifs or sundowners on the sun deck – plus an amazing view of Lake Müritz. Regular theme evenings, brunch buffet and BBQ.  
**Cooking boxes:** Interesting recipes plus fresh ingredients in a box for you to cook yourself.
- Spa:** Luxurious approx. 220 m<sup>2</sup> sauna area (subject to charge) with bio-sauna and Finnish sauna. Heated outdoor pool and 400 m<sup>2</sup> relaxation area, lakeside sun deck with comfortable sun loungers and beach chair hire.
- Service:** Underground parking for each apartment (subject to charge), lifts, Wi-Fi, initial set of hand and bath towels, bed linen, tea towels as well as household and cosmetic items. Guests can also request a high chair, baby bath or cot. Bath robes (subject to charge). Dogs welcome.
- Marina:** The marina with its 120 m quay is right next door to the resort. It offers 65 moorings for boats of up to 18 m long and max. 6 m wide.
- Location & distances:** At the heart of the Mecklenburg Lake District on a narrow strip of land separating Lake Müritz and Feisnecksee lake to the south of the town of Waren. Feisnecksee is part of the adjacent Müritz National Park.  
**By car from:** Rostock: 100 km (1 hour) | Berlin: 175 km (2 hours) | Hamburg: 220 km (2,5 hours)  
**By plane** via Rostock, Berlin, Hamburg.  
**By train from:** Berlin (1,5 hours) | Hamburg (2,5 hours) | Waren (Müritz) rail station approx. 2,5 km from the resort.  
**By boat** Waren is connected to all waterways via the federal waterways, the numerous canals and the lakes, so it is easy to travel here by boat from Berlin or Hamburg. The sea port of Rostock and the ferry port of Sassnitz-Mukran are directly accessible via the A19 or A20/B96 motorways.
- Excursion destinations:** Numerous water sports, e.g. sailing, surfing, kiting, canoeing, kayaking and stand-up paddling at Lake Müritz. Or land-based activities such as hiking, cycling and jogging.  
  
Müritzeum Nature Experience Centre, summer toboggan run, tree ropes course, Müritz National Park, various zoos and lots of other nearby excursion destinations. Guests who are interested in culture and history can take a trip to Malchow (30 minutes), Plau am See (45 minutes), Neustrelitz (45 minutes), Rostock (75 minutes) and the regional capital Schwerin (105 minutes).
